## **'Appraisathon' to Benefit Project Lifesaver** *May 6 Event at The Chelsea at Warren*

**WARREN** – Somerset County's version of "Antiques Roadshow" will come to The Chelsea at Warren at 274 King George Road on **Saturday, May 6**, from **1 to 4 p.m.**

Proceeds will benefit Project Lifesaver, a joint program of the Somerset County Office on Aging and Somerset County Sheriff's Office. The program provides electronic bracelets to individuals suffering from Alzheimer's and other disorders, such as autism, to aid in locating those who may wander off.

The community is invited to attend the May 6 "Appraisathon." Four appraisers from Somerville Center Antiques, New Jersey's largest antiques super center, will appraise items brought in by the public. Costs for appraisals are \$5 per item or \$10 for three items. Pictures of large objects are acceptable. All appraisals are verbal, non-binding opinions of the value of each item. Refreshments will be served.

The specialists will appraise in the areas of art, modern furnishings, fine porcelain and glassware, toys, dolls, jewelry, silver, books, textiles and 1950s modern. Somerville Center boasts 220 dealers in five buildings and sells 4,000 items a month.
