## **Non-Support Warrant Sweep Results in 29 Arrests**

The Somerset County Sheriff's Office arrested a total of 29 men and women from Dec. 2 through 4 as part of a statewide crackdown on those who are delinquent in making child-support payments. The total owed by those arrested in Somerset County is almost \$316,938.

More than 50 Sheriff's Officers, operating in teams, served outstanding warrants and made arrests.

"The roundup was conducted to remind parents of the importance of making regular child-support payments and hopefully to renew their commitment to do the right thing," said Sheriff Frank J. Provenzano. "These roundups are critical to the children of our state. Child support is a lifeline for our children and families in need. Parents have an obligation to pay. If they don't, rest assured we will be there to remind them of their obligation.

"These roundups also provide an additional incentive to delinquent parents to pay up once they know we are looking for them," he said. "Knowing that they face possible arrest encourages a delinquent parent to uphold their obligations or face incarceration. It creates a compounding effect of payments that lasts weeks after the roundup."

Among the 29 arrests, Anthony Frazier of Franklin had an additional contempt-of-court warrant and Adam DeCola of Raritan was arrested for various drug offenses. DeCola was charged with third-degree possession of a controlled dangerous substance, possession of marijuana and possession of narcotics paraphernalia. The Somerset County Prosecutor's Office and Raritan Borough Police Department also assisted.
